Sandy Crole's large ink and watercolour paintings of rural churches capture both the intricacy and romance of these fine historic buildings that make the English landscape so distinctive. The exhibition includes paintings of the Oxfordshire churches of St John the Baptist, Burford and St Giles, Oxford.

Sandy Crole graduated in Fine Art from St Martins in 1986. Now living and teaching in London, he has exhibited at the Singer and Friedlander exhibitions, in Southwark Cathedral, and has works in private collections.
